

EDGEWOOD COLLEGE IMMUNIZATION POLICY

All Edgewood College Students (residents and non-residents)

- **MMR:** 2 (two) MMRs required
 - o (If only 1 MMR has been done, then a second MMR is required to achieve immunity)

All International Students/Foreign Exchange Students

- **MMR:** 2 (two) MMRs required
 - o (If only 1 MMR has been done, then a second MMR is required to achieve immunity)
- **Tb Test:** Negative Tb Test (or Chest X Ray Clearance/appropriate treatment)
 - o **EXCEPTION:** Those who have lived in the following countries for 5 years do not need a TB skin test: Canada, Jamaica, Saint Kitts and Nevis, Saint Lucia, USA, Virgin Islands (USA), Belgium, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Liechtenstein, Luxembourg, Malta, Monaco, Netherlands, Norway, San Marino, Sweden, Switzerland, United Kingdom, American Samoa, Australia, or New Zealand.

Waiver:

- If a student chooses to forgo the MMR immunizations due to personal or religious reasons, then they **MUST** fill out the Edgewood College Immunization Exemption Form and have it notarized

Recommended Vaccines:

- The General Assembly of the State of Wisconsin Mandates that each public or private postsecondary institution in the state provide information concerning Hepatitis B infection to all students entering the institution for the first time. Those students who will be living in on-campus housing must also be informed about the risk of meningococcal meningitis infection. Students are required to sign a statement of understanding that they have ready about Hepatitis B and Meningococcal disease and understand the risk factors and dangers of each disease as well as information on the availability and effectiveness of the respective vaccines for persons who are at-risk for the diseases.
