Furnishings and Features

All of the rooms in the residence halls include the following basic furniture for each resident: twin, extra long bed (36" by 80"), desk and chair, blinds, dresser, and closet space. Each room includes Internet access (including wireless), cable television access and an optional in room telephone.

Resident Assistants

The Residence Life staff is comprised of four professional staff members and 20 student staff members (Resident Assistants). Resident Assistants (or RAs) are upperclass students who provide leadership in the residence halls.

Meal Plans

Students living in the new hall, Marshall, Regina, and Stevie Halls are required to have a meal plan. Edgewood offers "declining balance" meal plans of 1,450, 1,650, or 1,850 meal dollars per semester. Students have the option of adding additional meal dollars to their account.

Meal dollars can be used to purchase items à la carte at one of two dining facilities on campus: Phil's Dining Hall (Regina) and the Wingra Café (Predolin).

The Director of Dining Services and a campus dietician are available for consultation for students with allergies or special dietary needs.

Health and Safety

Edgewood College also has a Health Center staffed by a full-time nurse practitioner, counseling services, and a Security Department which provides 24/7 coverage to help ensure that students and areas across campus are healthy and safe.

Frequently Asked Questions

When can I submit my application and housing contract?

We will accept your housing contract and application after December 15.

When is the housing contract due?

We ask that you submit your housing contract by May 1.

May I cancel the housing application?

Yes, housing applications can be cancelled until May 1. Cancellation requests must be made in writing. Send your request to the Residence Life Office at ResidenceLifeOffice@edgewood.edu.

When will I learn which residence hall I'll be living in?

Your housing assignment will be emailed to your Edgewood College email account shortly after July 15.

When will I find out who my roommate is?

If you are assigned to a double or triple, you will receive the name and contact information of your roommate(s) shortly after July 15.

Housing Timeline

December // Submit your housing application and contract (which will be sent by mail) in December to reserve your spot. Housing assignments are based on the date your housing application is received. You may also apply and update your preferences online.

May 1 // Cancellations must be received by May 1. Requests must be made in writing. Send your request to the Residence Life Office.

July 15 // Shortly after July 15 you will receive notification regarding which residence hall you've been assigned to and, if applicable, the name(s) and contact information of your roommate(s).

Late July // Join other freshmen for a Summer Social. This is an opportunity to connect with your roommate(s) and meet other new students.

Late August // Move-In Day



LIVING ON CAMPUS

The goal for on-campus housing is to enrich the college experience and strengthen the sense of community for all students. Research shows that the first two years of college are a critical time for students to develop academic and social networks. Students who live on campus are more likely to be involved on campus and graduate in four years. Therefore, Edgewood College is committed to providing a supportive and positive campus environment conducive to student engagement and learning for all students, particularly for our freshmen and sophomores.

All freshmen under the age of 21 are required to live on campus for their first two academic years unless they choose to live with a family member and/or legal guardian (over the age of 25) within commuting distance. Exceptions to this policy include: students who have children, live in domestic partnerships, are veterans or are studying part-time.

Room Assignments and Roommates


Room and roommate assignments are completed in mid-July and priority is given to students based on the date they submit their housing contract. Students have the opportunity to request a roommate; however, all students must request to live with one another on their housing contract for the match to be attempted. A majority of residential students do not request to live with someone they know; they are matched to roommates based on their responses regarding their living preferences on the housing contract.



WEST REGINA

- 107 residents, primarily freshmen.
- Coed hall.
- Community bathrooms on each floor with a sink/vanity in every room.
- Majority of the rooms are singles with built-in wardrobe, closet, desk and shelving (2 doubles are available).

- Each floor has a tv with cable, a kitchen and free laundry facilities. Phil's Dining Hall, a computer lab, the chapel, and classrooms are also housed in Regina.
- The building is centrally air conditioned.

STEVIE HALL

- 121 residents, primarily freshmen.
- Coed by suite.
- Suites are two very large bedrooms connected by a shared bathroom with two sinks on each side, two showers, and one toilet.
- Each floor lounge offers cable TV and a kitchenette for resident use.

- Free laundry facilities are located on each floor.
- The building is centrally air conditioned.




Double or triple room with shared bath

- 53 residents, primarily freshmen.
- Coed by wing.
- The two wings are connected by the Pine Room Lounge, a kitchen and shared free laundry facilities. There is cable TV and a pool table in the lounge.

- Marshall has a mix of single and double rooms.




Double room

EAST REGINA

- Primarily freshmen and sophomore hall housing 126 students.
- Coed by room. Rooms are arranged in pods around community bathrooms.
- Each floor lounge offers cable TV and a kitchenette for resident use.

- Free laundry facilities are located on each floor.
- The building is centrally air conditioned.
