

EDGEWOOD COLLEGE + MADISON COLLEGE ELEMENTARY EDUCATION PATHWAY GUIDE USING THE LIBERAL ARTS TRANSFER – ASSOCIATE OF ARTS

If students take the recommended classes below, they will have completed a number of the requirements for the Psychology major prior to transferring to Edgewood College.

ENGLISH AND SPEECH REQUIREMENTS 9 CREDITS

Six credits must be in composition. English 1 and one other composition course are required. Three credits must be in public speaking.

- 6 credits in Composition: 801-201 English 1 (3) AND 801-202 English 2 (3)
- 3 credits in Public Speaking: 801-196 Oral/Interpersonal Communications (3)

HUMANITIES/FINE ARTS 15 CREDITS

Select from at least three disciplines: art, drama, film, literature, music, philosophy, world languages, writing and communication, and interdisciplinary humanities. If the language requirement has been fulfilled in high school (2 years with no grades below a C) it is recommended that students' select credits from the other disciplines in humanities/fine arts.

- Discipline 1: Literature 810-227 Children's Literature (3) *
- Discipline 2: Philosophy 809-263 East/West World Views (3)
- Discipline 3: Studio Art 815-205 Drawing Fundamentals (3) *
- 6 additional credits from Art appreciation/history, creative writing, drama, film, literature, communications, music history or theory, philosophy, world languages.

If the language requirement was not fulfilled: World Languages: i.e. 801-211 Spanish 1 (4) and 801-212 Spanish 2 (4)

MATH AND NATURAL SCIENCE 11 CREDITS

One mathematics course at the level of Intermediate Algebra or higher meets the minimum mathematics requirement. One biological science course and one physical science course are required. One of the science courses must include a laboratory.

- 804-212 College Algebra (4) **Students will still be required to complete math requirements at Edgewood College*
- 806-203 Introductory Zoology (5)
- 806-244 General Geology (3)

SOCIAL SCIENCE 15 CREDITS

Select from at least three disciplines: anthropology, economics, political science, history, psychology, sociology, and interdisciplinary social science

- Discipline 1: Political Science 809-221 American National Government or 809-222 State and Local Government (3) *
- Discipline 2: Psychology 809-233 – Developmental Psychology or 809-239 - Child Human Development (3) *
- Discipline 3: any from anthropology, economics, history, psychology, sociology, and interdisciplinary social science (3)
- 6 additional credits from anthropology, economics, history, political science, psychology, sociology, and interdisciplinary social science. It is highly recommended that students focus on one specific discipline with these credits – it may be beneficial as students pursue a required content minor as part of their education major

ELECTIVES 13 CREDITS

Select college transfer courses beyond the minimum requirements. A maximum of one credit of a physical education activity course may be selected.

- 307-187 Children Who are Differently Able (3) – Highly Recommended *
- 805-260 Music Theory Fundamentals (3) – Highly Recommended, fulfills DPI requirement *
