

**International Baccalaureate Exams  
Foundations Equivalents & Credits Awarded (Sept 2007)**

Students may earn college credit for scores of 4 or better on Higher Level International Baccalaureate (IB) exams. Credit is not granted for Standard Level exams. A student may not earn credit for an Edgewood or transfer course if credit for that course has already been earned through the IB exam program.

Students who complete the full International Baccalaureate Diploma (score of  $\geq 24$ ) will be awarded credit for each of their Higher Level exams and 3 additional credits for fulfillment of PHIL 101 Logic: The Practice of Critical Thinking.

Equivalencies are for Foundations credit only; students who wish to earn credit for a major or minor course equivalent must consult the appropriate school or department.
