# SOCIOLOGY PATHWAY GUIDE

## USING THE LIBERAL ARTS TRANSFER – ASSOCIATE OF ARTS

If students take the recommended classes below, they will have completed a number of the requirements for the Sociology major prior to transferring to Edgewood College. Always consult with an advisor from Madison College for any updates and changes.

### ENGLISH AND SPEECH REQUIREMENTS ..... 9 CREDITS

Six credits must be in composition. English 1 and one other composition course are required. Three credits must be in public speaking.

- 6 credits in Composition: 801-201 English 1 (3) AND 801-202 English 2 (3)
- 3 credits in Public Speaking: 801-196 Oral/Interpersonal Communications (3)

### HUMANITIES/FINE ARTS ..... 15 CREDITS

Select from at least three disciplines: art, drama, film, literature, music, philosophy, world languages, writing and communication, and interdisciplinary humanities. If the language requirement has been fulfilled in high school (2 years with no grades below a C) it is recommended that students' select credits from the other disciplines in humanities/fine arts.

- Discipline 1 Student choice
- Discipline 2 Philosophy: 809-263 East/West World Views (3) substitution permitted in consultation with your advisor
- Discipline 3 Literature is required: Introduction to Literature 801-204 (3) substitution permitted in consultation with your advisor
- 6 additional credits from Art appreciation/history, creative writing, drama, film, literature, communications, music history or theory, philosophy, world languages.

If the language requirement was not fulfilled: World Languages: i.e. 801-211 Spanish 1 (4) and 801-212 Spanish 2 (4)

### MATH AND NATURAL SCIENCE ..... 11 CREDITS

One mathematics course at the level of Intermediate Algebra or higher meets the minimum mathematics requirement. One biological science course and one physical science course are required. One of the science courses must include a laboratory.

- Minimum: Intermediate Algebra 804-201 (4) –Or Social Science 809-230
- Environmental Science 806-286 (4) – substitution permitted, but a biological science course is required
- Earth Science Weather and Climate 806-245 (3) – substitution permitted, but a physical science course is required

### SOCIAL SCIENCE ..... 15 CREDITS

Select from at least three disciplines: anthropology, economics, political science, history, psychology, sociology, and interdisciplinary social science

- Discipline 1 Sociology: Introduction to Sociology 809-203 (3)
- Discipline 2 Anthropology: Cultural Anthropology and Human Diversity
- Discipline 3 Social Science: Ethnic Studies, Race and Ethnicity 809-252 (3)
- Discipline 4 Additional Recommendation: Stats for Social Science 809-230
- Discipline 5 Additional Recommendation: Social Psychology 809-225

### ELECTIVES ..... 13 CREDITS

Select college transfer courses beyond the minimum requirements.

- Anthropology: Anthropology of Myth, Magic and Religion 809-285 (3)
- Sociology: Marriage and Family 809-204 (3)
- 7 additional credits to fulfill 13 credits
