**Leadership Award for “Ethical Leadership”**

This award is given to Juniors and Seniors who demonstrate exceptional leadership and dedication to service. For nominations, it is suggested that students have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0, and be in good academic and judicial standing. (Call the Dean’s Office for GPA verification.)

*Since there is no one way to define outstanding leadership and service, the selection committee suggests that some of the following criteria to be used as a guide for your nomination:*

- ★ excellence in leadership within a student organization  
(This individual need not be the president of the group or indeed hold any official title or position; rather, the person is one who has provided leadership to the group, its members and the college community.)
- ★ leadership in service to the Edgewood campus and/or wider community
- ★ leadership within a team context
- ★ inspirational leadership in the deepening of faith or the character development of others
- ★ ability to motivate others to do their best
- ★ organizational skills
- ★ integrity, including the ability to discern right from wrong, the willingness to act upon the knowledge, and the courage to stand up for a cause and take action for change

The selection committee composed of Student Affairs Committee faculty and staff will choose up to five students for awards.
