This award is given to Freshmen and Sophomores who are emerging campus leaders or potential scholars. It is recommended that nominated students have a GPA of at least 3.0, and be in good academic and judicial standing. (Call the Academic Dean’s Office for GPA verification.)

Since there is no one way to define outstanding of Dominican “spirit,” the selection committee suggests that some of the following criteria be used as a guide for your nomination:

- ★ a participatory spirit related to academic and campus activities that reflects Dominican values of truth, justice, compassion, partnership and community
- ★ constructive engagement in a particular activity, cause or academic interest on or off campus
- ★ whole-hearted energy and positive mindedness
- ★ innovative linking of curricular and co-curricular activities
- ★ awareness of a cause, courage to act and thoughtful action(s)
- ★ clear potential for greater leadership or scholarship in the coming years

The selection committee composed of Student Government Association faculty advisors and student members will choose up to five students for this award.
