The US Bureau of Labor Statistics cites excellent employment opportunities with high mean wages for those with a degree in accounting. Accounting, Tax Preparation, Bookkeeping, and Payroll Services professionals can earn as much as \$40 per hour on average.

Because it's a Bachelor's degree, you are eligible to obtain Federal Financial Aid. Also, it broadens the availability of scholarship funding.

1. A completed application.

2. A Official transcripts reflecting completion of a baccalaureate or more advanced degree from a United States regionally

accredited or equivalent post-secondary institution with a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale. The cumulative grade point average is computed on the highest degree held at the time of application.
