

New Freshman Financial Aid

EDGEWOOD COLLEGE

SCHOLARSHIPS

Students admitted to Edgewood College are automatically considered for a number of academic scholarships. A student's cumulative high school GPA and ACT or SAT scores are taken into consideration to determine the value of the scholarship. The value of these scholarships ranges from \$3,000 to \$12,000 per year.

AWARDS

Students admitted to Edgewood College are invited to apply for additional merit and need-based awards. Students are selected for these awards based on their demonstrated interests and experiences in many areas, including: leadership, service, spirituality, music, art, theatre, creative writing, and foreign language. The value of these awards ranges from \$500 to \$6,000 per year.

GRANTS

Students who complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) will be considered for need-based grants. The College awards federal, state and Edgewood College grants. These grants do not need to be repaid.

LOANS

Students who complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) will also be considered for federal loan programs. All students are eligible for a Federal Stafford Loan and some students may also qualify for a need-based Federal Perkins Loan. Parents may be eligible for the Federal Parent Loan for Undergraduate Students (PLUS). These loans must be repaid.

EMPLOYMENT

The Edgewood Employment program provides campus jobs for students who apply. Students can earn money to help pay educational or personal expenses.

3. Apply for FAFSA PIN numbers for both parent and student at www.pin.ed.gov. The PIN serves as an electronic signature to complete the FAFSA online.
4. Complete the FAFSA at www.fafsa.gov. The priority deadline is March 1. You may file your FAFSA after January 1 for the next academic year.
