Applicants for admission to Edgewood College are required to submit the following:

- Application for Admission
- Official High School Transcripts— with cumulative GPA and class rank (if available)
- Official ACT or SAT scores
- \$30 Application Fee
- GED official score report (if high school transcripts are not available)

High school units of study:

- Applicants should present at least sixteen units of high school study, twelve of which should be chosen from among the following fields:
 - ⇒ Natural Science
 - ⇒ Math
 - ⇒ Social Science
 - ⇒ English
 - ⇒ Foreign Language
 - ◆ Two years of the same foreign language in grades 9-12 with grades of C or better is recommended; if not completed in high school, the equivalent will be required at Edgewood.
 - ⇒ History
 - ⇒ Religious Studies (one unit only)
 - ⇒ Speech
