The Career Development Program fosters opportunities for students to gain experience and develop the skills necessary to navigate their careers effectively and make meaningful contributions to their organizations and communities. The School of Business collaborates with local professionals and organizations to create opportunities for students to apply technical knowledge and practice skills in real-world settings. The Career Development Program includes a service practicum, an internship, and a 6-credit capstone course in which students integrate knowledge from previous business classes and apply it to a new ethical and sustainable business idea.

SAMPLE COURSES

BUS 280 - Financial Accounting

Explores the role of financial accounting in measuring and communicating business activities to external users.

BUS 304 - Business Law

Provides students with an understanding of how the law affects business operations, and skills to use current technology in completing a legal research project involving a current ethical issue.

BUS 455 - Organizational Sustainability & Innovation

Explores the fundamental concepts of and relationship between organizational sustainability and innovation.
