Scholarships

The Social Innovation & Sustainability Leadership program offers a limited number of scholarships on an annual basis. Scholarship awards typically range from \$500-\$1,500 and are based on merit and need. A scholarship application, available on our program web site, needs to be filled out and submitted by June 15.

Comparing Costs

The costs for an Edgewood College Social Innovation & Sustainability Leadership graduate degree is comparable to the cost for full-time students completing their graduate degree in 2 years at area public institutions (including tuition, fees, books & supplies). A degree from Edgewood College provides a personal, flexible experience to help you accomplish your educational goals. Through classroom and community/organizational project experience working with regional professionals, you'll develop a network of social innovators and sustainability leaders to help you accomplish your professional goals.

*Costs are based on 2019-20 tuition (at \$996 per credit) and fees. Tuition costs can be expected to rise by approximately 3.5% annually.

**Tuition and materials costs for electives can vary depending on which courses are chosen.

***Students are expected to purchase any required course materials and books, which typically do not exceed \$50 per course. Books and materials costs are included in the course fees for SUST 650, but not for other courses. Course fees may change.
