

## Frequently Asked ?s

- **What if I'm unsure about where I want to live next year?**  
Visit our website for details on what Edgewood has to offer or stop by the Office of Residence Life to talk through what we have available.
- **What are my chances of getting into the space that I want?**  
There are several factors involved including:  
-Where residents reclaim their spaces  
-The number of students who intend on returning to on-campus housing next year  
-Your sign-up slot
- **What if I am unable to attend sign-up?**  
Sign up will be on Edgewood Express this year. Once your slot opens, you can select a space at any time up through April 10th at 8am.
- **What are the on-campus costs for next year?**  
The 2023-2024 rates are pending Board of Trustees approval. Tentative rates are posted on [residencelife.edgewood.edu](http://residencelife.edgewood.edu)
- **What rooms and apartments are available here on-campus?**  
Hall info is available on our website, including photos and floorplans.
- Keep in mind that people may reclaim spaces and that other circumstances that require prior placement may limit the availability of specific room types.
- **What if I am graduating, studying abroad, or student teaching outside of the Madison area?**  
You may still sign up for housing but be sure to indicate a partial year contract.
- **What if I'm a student involved in the Cutting Edge program?**  
Cutting Edge students will receive their Housing assignments from the Cutting Edge program staff via email.
- **What if I want to pull in a current first year freshman?**  
We can't guarantee that a new freshman can be placed with a returning student but please email [residencelife@edgewood.edu](mailto:residencelife@edgewood.edu) and we can attempt to honor th request.
- **Who can I live with?**  
You have the option to choose who you want to live with. Students may opt to claim a space as co-ed, or same gender, and can indicate this on their application.
- **What is this pet policy all about?**  
We will again be offering pet-friendly housing in the Siena apartments. One dog or cat will be allowed per apartment. Please see full details at [residencelife.edgewood.edu](http://residencelife.edgewood.edu)

## SIGN-UP GUIDE

## STEP 1

Apply by submitting an Housing App on Edgewood Express by Monday, March 20 (no deposit required)

Reclaimed, or got pulled into a reclaimed room?  
You're done, if not continue on!

## STEP 2

Select Roommates  
Starting March 13th, you can visit Edgewood Express and request and confirm your roommates anytime before March 27th.

Pro tip: Consider your housing options & have a back up plan!

## STEP 3

Choose your room or apartment for next year as soon as your sign-up slot opens April 3-5!

\*\*The roommate with the earliest slot, picks for everyone!

## Who should sign-up?

- Aspiring sophomores (started at EC in '22-'23) must sign up
- Upper-class students who are interested in signing up to live on-campus for the next academic year.

## How does sign-up work?

Each student should submit an application by Monday, March 20. Students who apply by the deadline will be able to indicate requested roommates in a separate process and then assigned a time slot to select their housing for 2023-2024 during their assigned time slot:

- Upper-Class sign-up on Monday, April 3rd
- Aspiring Sophomore sign-up Tuesday and Wednesday, April 4th-5th
- Students will be able to sign up using Edgewood Express.

## How are Sign-Up Slots assigned?

Sign-up slots are assigned based on the number of accumulated credit hours earned by the end of Winterim 2023 and priority is based on total credit hours completed. Students with the most credits are assigned first (i.e. better) numbers (students with the same number of credit hours will be ordered randomly.)

## Roommates, Reclaims & Pull-ins

You have the option to choose who you want to live with. Any student may request to reclaim their current room and space with the exception of rooms listed on the non-reclaimable list, located on our website. Starting on March 13th, the Roommate Request portal will open. Once all perspective roommates have signed up for housing, select one student to be the leader who will then invite ALL REQUESTED roommates to join the roommate group. It is important to make sure only one student (the "leader") invites everyone to the roommate group. All roommates must confirm the invite by March 27th to be able to select a space together April 3-5. The student with the earliest sign up time will select for all roommates/suitemates in a group. We encourage students to fill the apartment or room completely but this is not required.

## What options are there?

Aspiring Sophomores and Upper-class Options may include:

### Traditional Residence Halls Spaces:

- East Regina (Double)
- West Regina (Single)
- Dominican ( 4-person Suite)

Upper-class students also have the option to select an apartment space:

### Dominican Apartments (Co-Ed option):

- Four 5-person apartments with private single bedrooms
- Two 3-person apartments with private single bedrooms

### Dominican Co-op Apartment (Co-Ed option):

- There is one 12-person co-op on 4th floor Dominican with a private kitchen.
- In the co-op there are two 4-person pods with all single rooms and one 4-person pod with two single rooms and one double room

### Siena Apartments (Co-Ed, pet-friendly option):

- Nine 2-or 3-person apartments in Siena, each with its own kitchen-2 bedrooms - each apartment has 2 bedrooms
- the Siena Apartments will again be pet friendly. One dog or cat will be allowed per apartment (restrictions apply; see Siena Pet Policy for more info).

### Weber Apartments:

- Seventeen 1-or 2-person apartments in Weber, each with a kitchen - each apartment has 1 bedroom
