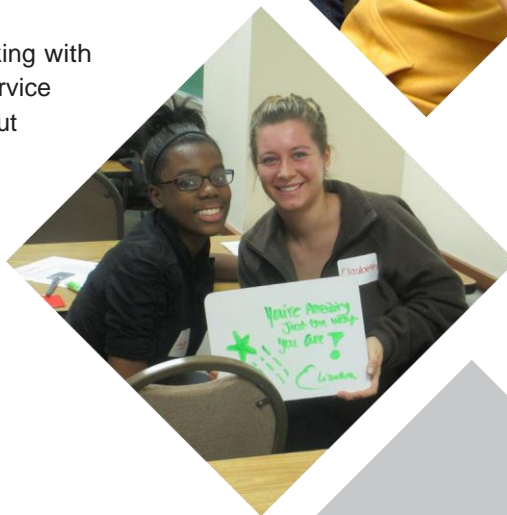

Looking for a Leadership Role?

Bonner Leaders is a service-learning leadership program allows students to provide community service while growing as a leader. Opportunities will be given to students to lead in small teams, as well as in the program as a whole. Bonner Leaders strive to understand issues in our own community, including poverty, homelessness and education. Students are encouraged to work hand-in-hand with the community to work for social change.



Bonner Leaders spend a minimum of two years working with other Edgewood College students on community service initiatives and meet regularly as a group to learn about social justice issues, community leadership and civic engagement. Students receive \$3,000 per year and complete 220 hours of community service and training.



Benefits

- Up to \$3000 in tuition awards per year (scholarship is renewable)
- Be part of a dynamic team of students committed to community service
- Learn hands-on leadership and professional skills
- Apply what you are learning in the classroom to real-world issues
- Participation is an asset for many graduate schools and employers

Qualifications

To qualify for the Bonner Leaders Program, you must be a full-time Edgewood College undergraduate student. Further, you must be willing to complete 220 hours of community service work over a one-year time period. You will work with a team of other students providing service at a specific community site and completing educational workshops. You will also

have the opportunity to engage in other community service activities of your choice throughout the program.
